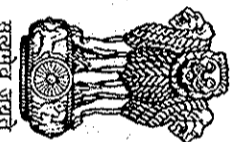

## About the Awards

The National Intellectual Property (IP) Awards are conferred to recognize and reward creators and innovators of IP who have contributed in harnessing the country's Intellectual Capital and creating an ecosystem which boosts creativity and innovation. The awards were constituted by the Intellectual Property Office, India in 2009.

They are intended to encourage innovation and management of intellectual property portfolio in such a manner that it influences the success of a business, whether large or small, in different industry segments.

Given every year on the occasion of the World Intellectual Property Day, i.e., 26th April, the awards aim to increase people's awareness and understanding of intellectual property. The date of 26th April was chosen by the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), headquartered in Geneva, to celebrate and promote the understanding of the role of intellectual property in our everyday lives as it was on this date that the WIPO Convention came into force in 1970.

## Categories of Awards

The categories for 2013 IP Awards were:

- Top Indian Academic Institution in Patents
- Top R&D Institution in Patents
- Top Indian Public Limited Company / Private Limited Company / Indian Subsidiary of a Transnational Corporation in Patents, for R&D Conducted in India and Subsequent First Filing in India for the Said Developed Invention
- Top Indian Private Company (MSME) in Patents
- Top Individual in Patents
- Top Organization in Trade Marks
- Top Organization in Design
- Top Individual in Design

## Judging Criteria

Unlike previous years, this year more parameters were included for selecting the winners keeping in mind the fact that the Awards should not only reflect IPRs granted but also the awardee's spirit and actions in taking the IPR culture forward. The Awards are based on a company's performance in increasing, maintaining and leveraging its IPR portfolio over a period of five years taken for evaluating the awardees (for 2013 Awards).

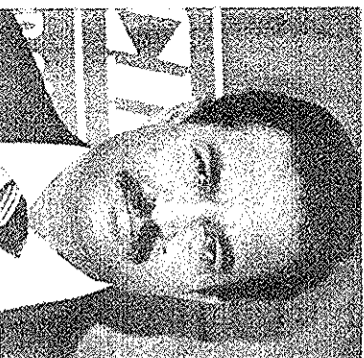

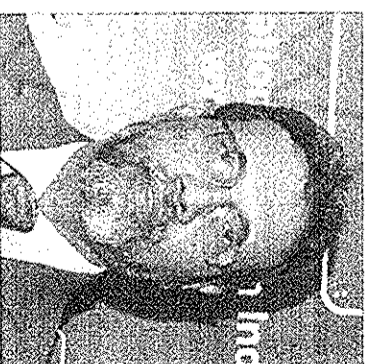
